I wonder what people think if I drag the rooms out of public space.

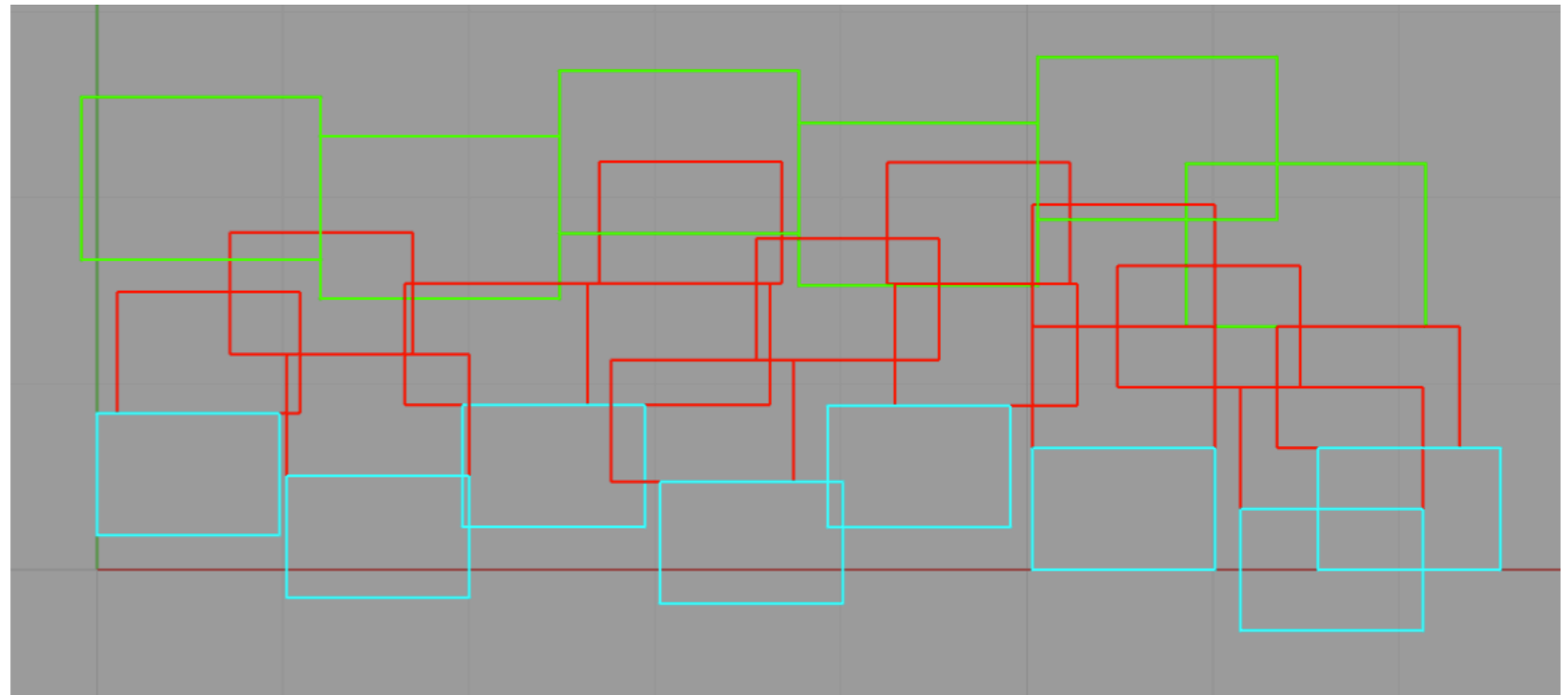
The way to make it

Re-organization

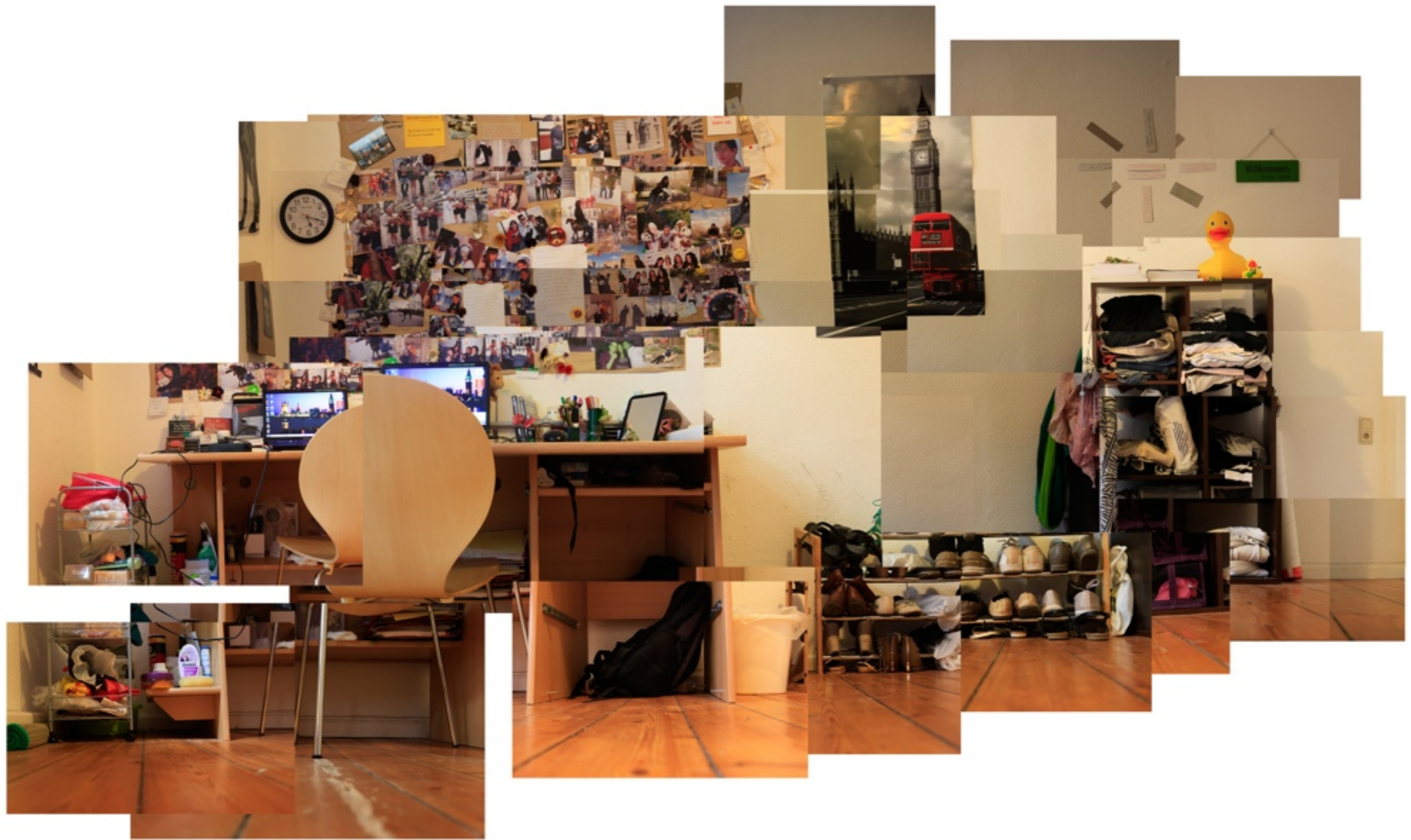
- Like buying things and decorating the room, small photos are making big image.
